Anytime you plan to excavate, including digging, **you must** use Iowa One Call. Iowa

One Call provides contractors, homeowners, and others who may be excavating, digging, or trenching with a toll-free number to call for locating and marking underground facilities. The toll-free Iowa One Call number is 1-800-292-8989. You may also dial 811.

Iowa law requires you to call Iowa One Call at least 48 hours in advance in order to minimize the risk of damaging any type of underground facilities (electric, gas, telecommunications, water and sewer). **This service is free.**

The law applies to professional contractors as well as homeowners, and encompasses a wide array of outdoor projects including:

- ..# Installing a fence
- ..# Planting trees or shrubs
- ..# Building a patio, addition, deck, garage, outdoor shed or any similar structure that requires any form of digging
- ..# Putting in a new driveway
- ..# Installing a septic system or water drainage system
- ..# Terracing or landscaping

Low-Income Telephone Assistance

Link-Up

Link-Up assists qualified low-income Iowans in obtaining basic telephone service by providing reduced connection charges for basic phone service by 50% or \$30, whichever is less.

Lifeline

Lifeline assists qualified low-income Iowans by providing a monthly credit on their telephone bill in an amount up to \$8.25.

To be eligible an application must meet income based criterion currently defined as at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines OR participate in at least one of the following:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income
- Food Stamps
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- National School Lunch Program
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families

To sign up for the Low-Income Telephone Assistance Programs call or stop by the office to obtain an application.

The National Do Not Call Registry is open for business, putting consumers in charge of the telemarketing calls they get at home. The Federal government created the national registry to make it easier and more efficient for you to stop getting telemarketing calls you don't want. You can register online at WWW.DONOTCALL.GOV or call toll-free, 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236), from the number you wish to register. Registration is free. Most telemarketers should not call your number once it has been on the registry for 31 days. If they do, you can file a complaint on their Website. You can register your home or mobile phone for free. This registry does exclude you from receiving calls from telemarketers and other sales representatives, however it DOES NOT exclude you

from non profit organizations lists. Non profit organizations are still allowed to call you, but use caution when dealing with these organizations for you may become more susceptible to other organizations calling. It has been our personal experiences that once you donate to one charitable fund, your phone number is then cycled through a list for other non profit organizations.
